## *Love God*

At God's Grace, we are committed to honoring God through our presence, fellowship with others, and joining God in the world to serve others. To *Love God*, we come together to encounter the spiritual and meet God is an anchor point on the journey. Sharing facilities at Rock Canyon High School, worship is open to everyone. Our service begins with inspiring music from a mix of different artists; offers a fun and engaging Children's Church breakaway for age-divergent teaching; and includes thought-provoking sermons that connect Scripture to everyday life experiences, prayers, and Holy Communion. *Love God* costs include facility leasing, worship materials and a portion of staff salaries: 50% Lead Pastor, 25% Outreach Minister, 25% Executive Minister, and 33% Administrative Minister; and worship support and music staff. Our talented musicians and media technicians provide meaningful and spiritual music and video messages that enrich the relevant worship experience.

Daily devotions written by GGCC participants posted on the website or emailed enable the movement from Sunday into Monday and beyond to continue the journey to *Love God*. ## *Love People*

GGCC ministries to *Love People* affirm that Jesus surrounds people during key life transitions to grow with God and that Jesus nurtures individuals in relationships. *Adult ministry* includes small group Bible studies, retreats, classes, and other events hosted by GGCC and partner organizations. *Children's ministry* provides children an introduction to God's love and grace while building a developmental faith foundation. From Children's Church on Sundays, to Rites of Passage intergenerational workshops, we encourage children and support families to join us in ministry. *Youth ministry* supports families to grow healthy youth. The Firm for 6-8<sup>th</sup> graders meets weekly for fellowship and spiritual learning that is engaging, experiential, relational and fun! 707 (SEEK & ASK, MATT 7:7) Sr. High youth ministry encourages high school students to share and grow in faith. College students and impact adults assist in mentoring this group. A popular tradition is mission trips, where kids share God's love and join Jesus at work in different settings. *Pastoral Care* ministry provides compassion, notes, visits, and calls during times of crisis, for prayer concerns or the need for an extra bit of care and prayer to help deal with life's moments.

*Love People* costs include facility leasing, materials and supplies and staff: 25% Lead Pastor, 50% Executive Minister, 33% Administrative Minister, 25% Outreach Minister; and part-time staff. GGCC staff delivers excellent work and exhibit their love of God and people and service in their daily lives.

## *Serve the World*

From its beginning, God's Grace has had a missional focus as Jesus' love among us is measured by our capacity to *Serve the World*. In 2009, 5,190 lives were touched by GGCC participants giving (AT LEAST) 967 hours of time, as well as financial and in-kind donations. At *The Gathering Place*, 34 participants played bingo with 184 ladies; additionally over 400 toiletry and food items were given to support their operations. GGCC sponsors *Paris Elementary's* Terrific Readers & Writers: 59 participants awarded 177 books at award ceremonies attended by over 300 parents and siblings. The *Paris* community was supported with 604 school supplies, 13 backpacks, 40 Thanksgiving baskets, and 812 clothing items. 75 adults, youth and children renewed a Littleton block at Extreme Community Makeover with *Confluence Ministries*. GGCC continues to partner with *Open Door Youth Gang Alternatives* as 165 participants served at after school programs, parent meetings, summer picnics, and celebrated 500 children at the annual Christmas party as the only church partnering with *Open Door*. 450 student leaders attended Diversity Summits hosted by partner, *CETAV (Cameron Ebel Teens Against Violence)* to bring a message of tolerance and respect in 12 schools. *Serving the World* globally continues with our partnership with the *Haitian Timoun Foundation* to create a future of hope, sustainability, and dignity for the children of Haiti.
